Businesses Jacks Trucking and Weatherford International benefited.
2007	McMurry Training Center	3,000,000	Business Committed	Phased construction of a building owned by the JPB and leased to the Construction Careers Foundation for an expansion of the McMurry Training Center.
2008	Bishop Industrial Ranch Rail Spur	1,500,000	Community Readiness	Construct an 8,000+ foot long rail spur off the main line of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe.
